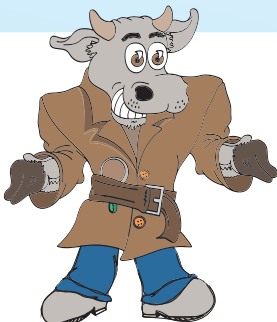

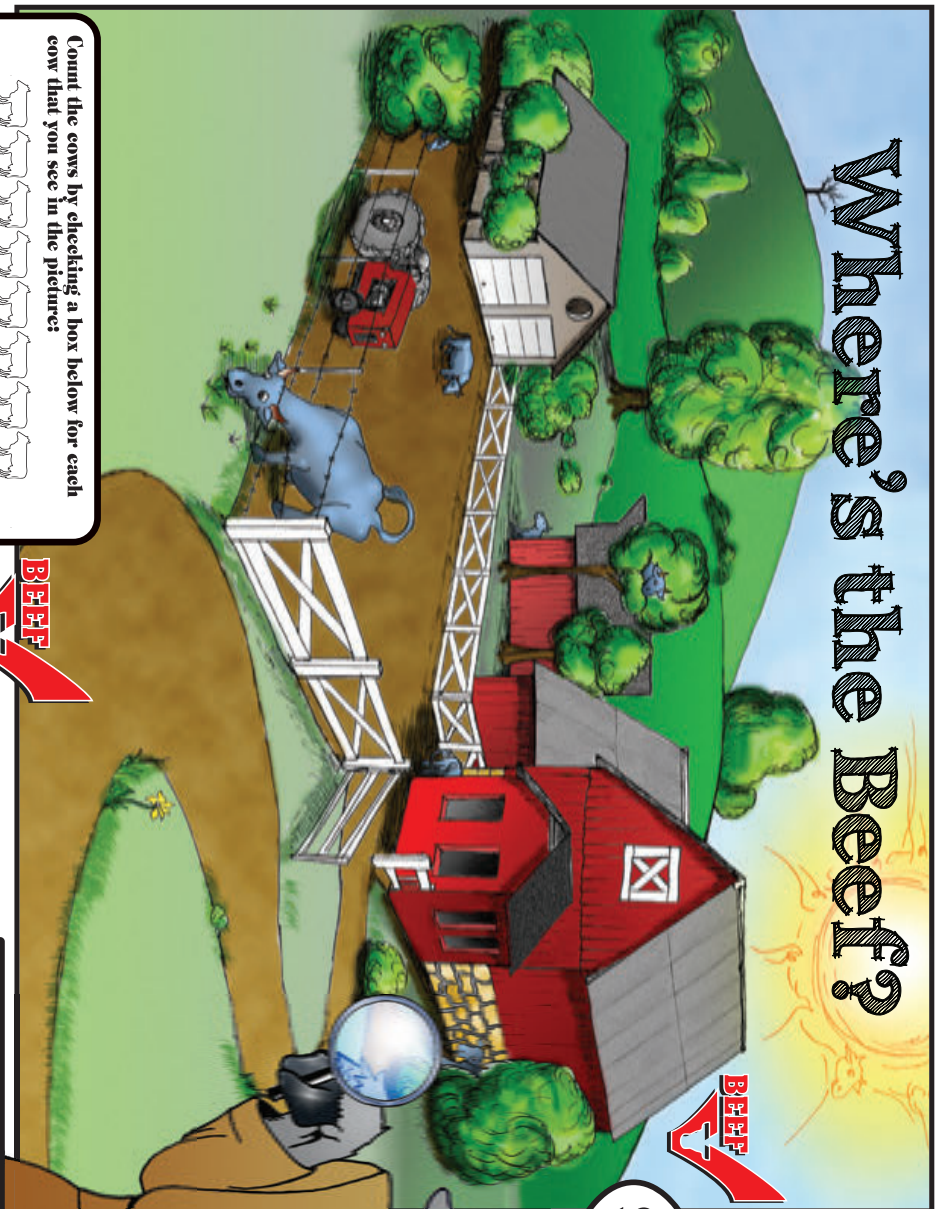

INGREDIENTS

- 1½ pounds ground beef (95% lean)
- ½ cup chopped onion
- ¼ teaspoon pepper
- ½ cup canned black beans, rinsed, drained
- ½ cup frozen corn
- ½ cup ketchup
- ½ cup barbecue sauce
- 6 whole wheat sandwich buns

DIRECTIONS

Brown ground beef and onion in large nonstick skillet over medium heat 8-10 minutes or until beef crumbles, and is no longer pink.

Season with pepper. Stir in beans, corn, ketchup and barbecue sauce.

Cook 3-5 minutes or until heated through, stirring occasionally.

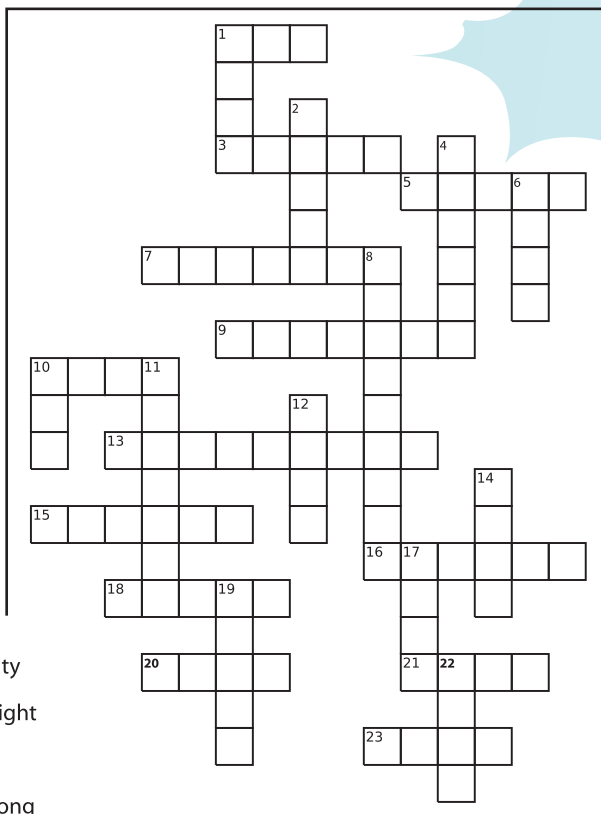
