Cattle give us far more than just meat, we use 99 percent of every beef animal! After we harvest the meat, the rest goes into "by-products." A by-product is something made in the process of making something else and cattle by-products are made after the meat is used. Marshmallows and vitamin capsules are made with gelatin, a cattle by-product. Crayons contain an oil that comes from cattle. Film, bone china and many kinds of medicine also contain cattle by-products.
